Bids are to be submitted in accordance with the Contract Documents prepared by the Commission.

**Prevailing Wage Rates and Equal Employment Opportunity requirements apply to this Project.**

**The Small Business Enterprise (DBE/EDGE/SBE) Goal applicable to this Project is 11%.**

**Pollution Liability Insurance is required under GC Art. 12.1.3 for this Project.**

Bids will be received for this Project, which includes the following:

Replace the existing deck and widen the decks on the twin mainline bridges at M.P. 40.3 and M.P. 40.5. Additional rehabilitation work at the bridges include replacement of the expansion joints and bearings; miscellaneous patching of the substructure, sealing of all construction joints; performing concrete weatherproofing; maintenance of traffic; and all other items incidental to the completion of the Work. All Work is to be performed as per the Plans, Drawings, Specifications, Special Provisions, Technical Specifications, and other Contract Documents for this Project. **NOTE** - Work for this Project will occur over the Indiana & Ohio Railway Company’s right-of-way. The Commission and the Railway have executed a Construction and Maintenance Agreement which will require the selected contractor to enter into the Railway’s standard right-of-Entry Agreement before entering the Railway’s right-of-way and to provide additional insurance. See Article 21 of the Construction Contract for additional information.

Bids will be accepted until **January 6, 2022, at 2:00 P.M. (Eastern Time)**, when all Bids will be accessed, opened and read aloud. Bidders should submit all questions no later than seven (7) days prior to Bid Opening.

Contract Documents are available by registering for a free vendor account and logging into Bid Express® (<https://www.bidexpress.com>). However, Bidders must obtain a paid subscription to Bid Express and select the Project for Bidding to submit a Bid.

The Contract Documents may be reviewed for bidding purposes without charge by registering and logging into Bid Express<sup>®</sup>.

A Contract will be awarded, if any award be made, to the Bidder determined to have submitted the lowest responsive and responsible Bid for the performance of the Work. The Commission reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to waive minor irregularities or technical deficiencies.
