Q#4 Site Manager – Are they required to spend 20 hours in each building or just 20 hours per set?

A#4 Site Manager is required to be on site a minimum of 20 hours per week **per set** of service plazas.

Q#5 Site Supervisor – What are the minimal hour requirements per location and or set?

A#5 Supervisory staff shall be continuously provided at a level that assures that all tasks are minimally performed at the specified frequencies and that the standards of the contract are continuously met. The respondent should detail the specifics of its proposed supervisory staffing plan in its Staffing Plan (Exhibit 2 to Appendix A) which shall be used to evaluate and score the respondent against alternate proposals.



SUPPLEMENTAL:

The Commission is currently undertaking an RFP process for the Food and Retail Concession Operator at the Blue Heron and Wyandot Service Plazas. It is likely that concession operations will continue to diminish and eventually cease in their entirety to allow for redevelopment the concession space until such time that new concession operations are established. This will likely take up one full year from the award of a new Concessions Contract. The plaza facilities will remain fully open during redevelopment for fuel, showers, vending, ATM and all other amenities. During this time, the Commission retains the authority to adjust the respective janitorial staffing requirements proportionately to reflect the lessor demand for resources, human or otherwise.

Subcontracting, if permitted, shall not relieve the Contractor or its surety of any of their obligations under this Contract. The Contractor shall be and remain solely responsible to the Commission for the acts or faults of its subcontractor and of such subcontractor's officers, agents and employees.
