ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 5:00 P.M. ON JANUARY 30, 2026:

Q#1 Is there a page limit to the responses?

A#1 There is no page limit. However, the Commission is looking for a concise, high level overview of the respondent's program that is responsive to Part II-Objectives of the RFI, Part III-Proposed Terms, and Part IV- Responses to the RFI.

Q#2 How does the commission plan to enforce the RV parking compliance? (i.e. if a RV has stayed longer than 24 hours, does the commission want to send out tickets.)

A#2 Plazas Staff will monitor occupancy and manage the RV parks. Commission will not ticket for stays over 24 hours. However, max fare toll charges will apply for each stay over 24 hours.

Q#3 Could you provide the details of the incumbent contract which currently provides these services? Or alternatively, can you confirm this is a new requirement?

A#3 This is a new program. The Commission owns and operates 14 service plazas along the 241-mile toll road. 8 of those plazas offer overnight RV parking with hook ups, potable water and dump stations. The Commission currently runs the program with cash only ticket machines that are reaching the end of their useful life. This program would replace and update the payment systems for RV travelers.
