ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 5:00 P.M. ON DECEMBER 23, 2025:

Q#1 How many cameras does the Commission have in total?

A#1 There are currently 1250 cameras in our existing Milestone Video Management System.

Q#2 What are the Commission's WIM systems, and what exactly do you want integrated?

A#2 The Commission's WIM systems are "weigh in motion" stations located at various mileposts across the Ohio Turnpike. WIM system notifications for overweight and over-dimensional vehicles would need to be integrated into the ATMS.

Q#3 How many portable message signs does the Commission have?

A#3 The Commission has an inventory of 76 portable changeable message signs.

Q#4 Does the Commission request all bidders to include cloud costs in their pricing?

A#4 If a respondent is short-listed and moves on to Phase Two, their Fee Proposal shall include any associated cloud costs for their proposed system.
