BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Highways be requested by this Commission to make the necessary traffic, engineering, and related studies for a toll turnpike project beginning at the eastern boundary of the State of Ohio, and connecting with the proposed Western Extension of the Pennsylvania Turnpike at the termination thereof at the Ohio boundary, and proceeding generally in a westerly direction across Ohio in accordance with all provisions of Section 1201 through 1222 of the General Code of Ohio, both inclusive, by hiring consulting engineers and using Highway Department engineers and other employees of the Highway Department therefor, at an estimated cost of \$600,000 for such studies, which amount, together with all other expenses incurred by the Highway Department for such studies, shall be reimbursed from Turnpike Revenue Bonds whenever sold by the Ohio Turnpike Commission for the construction of the proposed toll turnpike project.
