Resolution No. 6-1949

WHEREAS, many persons and organizations will seek to discuss matters of business with the Ohio Turnpike Commission;

AND, WHEREAS, members of the Commission look with disfavor upon individual solicitations by persons or concerns seeking employment by the Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that members of this Commission, as individuals, will not entertain persons seeking to discuss the business of the Commission or seeking business from, or employment by, the Commission, except at a regular meeting of the Commission or in the presence of the body of the Commission;

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the policy herein announced is not to be restrictive upon the Director of Highways in matters of primary concern to the Department of Highways.
