Resolution adopted March 20, 1952, the vote being recorded upon call of the roll, with the result of the vote as follows:

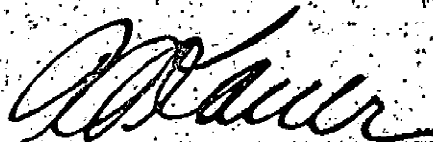
