OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

Resolution No. 150 - 1953 Finding it Necessary to Change the Location of a Portion of County Line Road, Trumbull County

WHEREAS a portion of County Line Road, a county road, in Trumbull County, Ohio, intersects the route to be traversed by Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1, hereinafter called "the turnpike"; and

WHEREAS §1206 of the Ohio General Code provides for the relocation of any portion of any public road upon the Commission's finding that it is necessary to change the location thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Commission, having duly and fully considered the same, finds it necessary to change the location of that portion of County Line Road, Lordstown Township, Trumbull County, Ohio, the centerline of which presently intersects the centerline of Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1 at or near turnpike station 564 + 14 and which extends from a point approximately 440 feet westerly from said intersection with Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1 easterly to a point which is the centerline intersection of County Line Road with State Route No. 45; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Commission be, and hereby is, instructed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of County Commissioners of Trumbull County, Ohio.
