Resolution No. 154 -1953 Finding it Necessary to Change the Location of a Portion of Oviatt-Windham Road, Trumbull County

WHEREAS a portion of Oviatt-Windham Road, a county road, in Trumbull County, Ohio, intersects the route to be traversed by Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1, hereinafter called "the turnpike"; and

WHEREAS \$1206 of the Ohio General Code provides for the relocation of any portion of any public road upon the Commission's finding that it is necessary to change the location thereof;

RESOLVED that the Commission, having duly and fully considered the same, finds it necessary to change the location of that portion of Oviatt-Windham Road, Braceville Township, Trumbull County, Ohio, the centerline of which presently intersects the centerline of Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1 at or near turnpike station 148 + 7 and which extends from a point at the centerline intersection of Oviatt-Windham Road with Newton Falls-Braceville Road to a point approximately 620 feet west of said intersection with Newton Falls-Braceville Road; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Commission be, and hereby is, instructed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of County Commissioners of Trumbull County, Ohio.
