

OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

Resolution No. 160 - 1953 Finding it Necessary to Change the Location of a
Portion of Gladstone Road, Mahoning County

WHEREAS a portion of Gladstone Road, a county road, in Mahoning County, Ohio, intersects the route to be traversed by Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1, hereinafter called "the turnpike"; and

WHEREAS §1206 of the Ohio General Code provides for the relocation of any portion of any public road upon the Commission's finding that it is necessary to change the location thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Commission, having duly and fully considered the same, finds it necessary to change the location of that portion of Gladstone Road, Jackson Township, Mahoning County, Ohio, the centerline of which presently intersects the centerline of Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1 at or near turnpike station 28 + 78 and which extends from a point 485 feet more or less east of the centerline intersection of Gladstone Road with State Route No. 45 to a point 1090 feet more or less westerly of the centerline intersection of Gladstone Road with State Route 45; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Commission be, and hereby is, instructed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of County Commissioners of Mahoning County, Ohio.
