

OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

Resolution No. 162 -1953 Finding it Necessary to Change the Location of
a Portion of Main Road, Erie County

WHEREAS a portion of Main Road, a county road, in Erie County, Ohio, intersects the route to be traversed by Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1, hereinafter called "the turnpike"; and

WHEREAS §1206 of the Ohio General Code provides for the relocation of any portion of any public road upon the Commission's finding that it is necessary to change the location thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Commission, having duly and fully considered the same, finds it necessary to change the location of that portion of Main Road, Berlin Township, Erie County, Ohio, the centerline of which presently intersects the centerline of Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1 at or near turnpike stations Nos. 1076 + 85 and 1057 + 50 and which extends from a point 1100' more or less southeasterly from the present intersection of Main Road and Fraley Road to a point distant 2850' more or less southeasterly from the present intersection of Main Road and Fraley Road; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Commission be, and hereby is, instructed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of County Commissioners of Erie County, Ohio.
