

OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

Resolution No. 338 -1953 Declaring the Necessity of Appropriating Property and Directing that Proceedings to Effect Such Appropriation be Begun and Prosecuted

RESOLVED that the Commission has endeavored for a reasonable time to agree with the owner or owners of the property described herein as to the compensation to be paid therefor, but has been unable to agree with said owner or owners, and said property is needed for the construction and efficient operation of the Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proceedings be begun and prosecuted to effect the appropriation of the following-described property from the following-named owner or owners and persons having interests therein, to-wit:

The aforementioned property to be appropriated is described as follows:

Parcel No. 101-B -- Fee Simple

That part of lot number eight (8) in subrange number six (6) in section number two (2) of Berlin Township, now in the Village of Berlin Heights, Erie County, Ohio, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning in the center line of the Ceylon Road (so-called) at the Southwest corner of said lot number 8, in subrange number 6; running thence North 89° 45' East, along the South line of said lot number 8, a distant of 15.23 chains to the West line of the land now or formerly owned by Joseph B. and Rosa Cosentino; thence North 1° West, along said last mentioned line, a distance of 1.313 chains; thence South 89° 45' West, 15.23 chains to the center line of the Ceylon Road; thence South 1° East, 1.313 chains to the place of beginning.
