OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

Resolution No. 382 -1953 Finding it Necessary to Change the Location of a Portion of Handle Road, Village of Strongsville, Cuyahoga County, Ohio

WHEREAS a portion of Handle Road in the Village of Strongsville, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, intersects the route to be traversed by Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1, hereinafter called "the turnpike"; and

WHEREAS \$1206 of the Ohio General Code provides for the relocation of any portion of any public road upon the Commission's finding that it is necessary to change the location thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Commission, having duly and fully considered the same, finds it necessary to change the location of that portion of Handle Road, Village of Strongsville, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, the centerline of which presently intersects the centerline of Ohio Turnpike Project No. 1 at or near turnpike station 479+31 and which extends from a point which is 561.4 feet south of the centerline intersection of Handle Road with Albion Road to the present intersection of Handle Road and Albion Road; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Commission be, and hereby is, instructed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Council of the Village of Strongsville, Strongsville, Ohio.
