

## OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

Resolution Authorizing the Transfer of Moneys From  
Reserve Maintenance Fund To the Redemption Account

WHEREAS, §509 of the trust deed of June 1, 1952 by and between the Ohio Turnpike Commission and The Ohio National Bank of Columbus as trustee, and The National City Bank of New York (now First National City Bank of New York), as co-trustee provides that the trustee shall from time to time transfer any moneys from the Reserve Maintenance Fund to the credit of the Redemption Account upon the receipt of a certified copy of a resolution duly adopted by the Commission directing such transfer, and a certificate of the Consulting Engineers certifying that the amount so to be transferred is not required for the purposes for which the Reserve Maintenance Fund has been created; and

WHEREAS, a certificate has been received by the Commission from the Consulting Engineers certifying that the amount of \$500,000 is not required for the purposes for which the Reserve Maintenance Fund has been created;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the trustee, The Ohio National Bank, upon receipt of the certificate of the Consulting Engineers, and upon receipt of certified copy of this resolution, be, and said trustee hereby is requested to transfer forthwith \$500,000 from the Reserve Maintenance Fund to the credit of the Redemption Account, all in accordance with §509 of the trust deed.
