## OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

## Resolution Adopting Supplement to Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 1968

WHEREAS pursuant to \$505 of the trust agreement dated June 1, 1952, entered into between the Ohio Turnpike Commission and The Ohio National Bank of Columbus, as trustee, and The National City Bank of New York (now First National City Bank), as co-trustee, the Commission, by resolution No. 20-1967 adopted an annual budget for the fiscal year 1968;

WHEREAS pursuant to \$505 of the said trust agreement, the Commission may, at any time, adopt an amended or supplemental annual budget for the remainder of the then current fiscal year;

WHEREAS experience in the operation of the Ohio Turnpike now indicates a need for certain supplementary budget allowances for the remainder of the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS a supplemental budget for the remainder of the year 1968 has been submitted to the Commission and the adoption thereof has been recommended by the Commission's Budget and Finance Committee, and said amendment to the budget is now before the Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Commission, having duly and fully considered the same, hereby adopts the following supplemental budget of current expenses for the fiscal year 1968:

Operations (increase in estimate) +230,000

Trust Indenture Expense (unchanged) - 0 
Total +\$240,000
