OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

Resolution Adopting Numerical Designation and Name for Interchange with C.R. 24 (S. R. 66) in Fulton County, Ohio

WHEREAS, the Commission and Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation heretofore, in accordance with law, have designated C. R. 24 (S. R. 66) as a point of ingress to and egress from the Ohio Turnpike;

WHEREAS, said new interchange has been designed and constructed at approximately Milepost 25.6 of the Ohio Turnpike near the City of Archbold, in Fulton County, Ohio and was officially opened to traffic on November 13, 1998;

WHEREAS, the Commission has previously named all other existing interchanges on the Ohio Turnpike; and

WHEREAS, the executive director has recommended that said interchange be designated **Exit No. 25** (also known as 2A) and named "**Archbold-Fayette**" and the Commission concurs in said recommendation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Commission hereby designates the new interchange between the Ohio Turnpike and C. R. 24 (S. R. 66) as **Exit No. 25** (also known as 2A) and adopts "**Archbold-Fayette**" as the name for said interchange.
