## **OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION**

## Resolution Authorizing Execution of the Collective Bargaining Agreement for Part-Time Employees in the Toll Collection Department

WHEREAS, separate negotiations have taken place between representatives of the Commission and United Electrical, Radio and Machine Workers of America, ("Union"), as representatives of all part-time employees in the Toll Collection Department; hereinafter referred to as "Part-Time Bargaining Unit Employees";

WHEREAS, the Union has been certified by the State Employee Relations Board as the exclusive bargaining representative of the Part-Time Bargaining Unit Employees";

WHEREAS, on March 12, 1998, the State of Ohio, State Employment Relations Board (SERB) under Case Number 97-REP-06-0132 approved the Petition for Amendment of Certification filed by the Union whereby it sought to amend the certification to add the words, "and its Local 791" to its name;

WHEREAS, the Commission's current Collective Bargaining Agreement for Parttime Toll Collectors with the Union expired June 30, 1997;

WHEREAS, the Union, as the exclusive bargaining representative of the Part-Time Bargaining Unit Employees, rejected the findings of Fact Finder Marvin Feldman dated August 17, 1998, and the part-time toll collectors have been working without an agreement up to the present time;

WHEREAS, after lengthy and intense negotiations, the parties have reached a separate agreement with the Part-Time Bargaining Unit Employees, which tentative agreement is now before the Commission;

WHEREAS, the tentative agreement which has been presented to the Part-Time Bargaining Unit Employees for ratification has been approved by a majority vote of the membership;

WHEREAS, the proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement shall be effective as of the date of execution, and shall be in full force and effect until 12:01 a.m., **March 1, 2002**, and further provides that said agreement may be extended or renewed for successive periods of three years unless written notice of termination is given by either the Commission or the Union;

WHEREAS, the approval of the tentative agreement has been recommended by the Commission's executive director and general counsel;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission hereby approves the tentative Collective Bargaining Agreement with its Part-Time Bargaining Unit Employees in the Toll Collection Department and authorizes and directs the chairman and/or executive director, with advice of general counsel, to execute the agreement with the Part-Time Bargaining Unit Employees in the Toll Collection Department on behalf of the Commission and to take any other action necessary to carry out the terms and provisions thereof.
