WHEREAS, the Commission has been advised by its general counsel that it may lawfully reject all bids for the aforesaid invitation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the above-mentioned bid, hereto received pursuant to the advertisement for bids upon Contract No. 38-93-01 for the engineering, furnishing, installing and testing of a nine-position, CRT-based Dispatch Console System at the above-mentioned locations along the Ohio Turnpike be and the same hereby is rejected, and the executive director is authorized to notify the bidder in writing of said action, to return to the bidder the bid security furnished by it and take whatever steps are necessary to re-advertise, forthwith.
