Resolution Expressing Appreciation of Earl W. Williams

WHEREAS, Earl W. Williams was appointed as a member of the Ohio Turnpike Commission by Governor George V. Voinovich on April 22, 1994;

WHEREAS, during his seven-year tenure as a member of the Commission, he was elected Vice-Chairman on June 22, 1998, a position which he holds until the expiration of his term on June 30, 2001;

Church, Cleveland, Ohio; and, being inducted into the Greater Cleveland Growth Association's "Leadership Cleveland," *Class of 1979;*
