

OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION

Resolution Rejecting the Findings of the Fact-Finder Relative to the Part-time Toll Collector Negotiations

WHEREAS, negotiations took place between representatives of the Commission and the United Electrical, Radio and Machine Workers of America ("Union"), as representatives of the part-time toll collectors, and certain unresolved issues were submitted to fact-finding under the provisions of Chapter 4117, Ohio Revised Code to a fact-finder appointed by the State Employment Relations Board, namely Grgory James Van Pelt;

WHEREAS, the fact-finder issued his recommendations and conclusions on March 1, 2002, and a copy of the report is attached hereto as "Attachment A";

WHEREAS, the Commission has reviewed said report and discussed the recommendations of the fact-finder with members of the Commission's negotiating team, the executive director, deputy executive director-chief engineer and general counsel; and

WHEREAS, it is of the opinion of the Commission that it is in its best interests to reject the recommendations and conclusions of the fact-finder;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Commission hereby rejects the recommendations, conclusions and findings of the fact-finder as set forth in his report and recommendations dated March 1, 2002 which is attached hereto as "Attachment A."
