WHEREAS, the Trust Agreement provides that the Commission shall file a copy of any amended annual budget with the Trustee; and

WHEREAS, the Commission's executive director, CFO/Comptroller and other members of the Commission's staff have completed a detailed review of the annual budget and have made certain adjustments thereto and the <u>amended</u> budget, including such adjustments, is now before the Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Commission hereby adopts the following as its <u>amended</u> annual budget for the year 2005 and the executive director or the CFO/Comptroller are directed to transmit a copy of the budget to the appropriate officials set forth in Section 5537.17(F) and to The Huntington National Bank, Trustee, under the Commission's Trust Agreement as is provided in Section 5.01(c):
